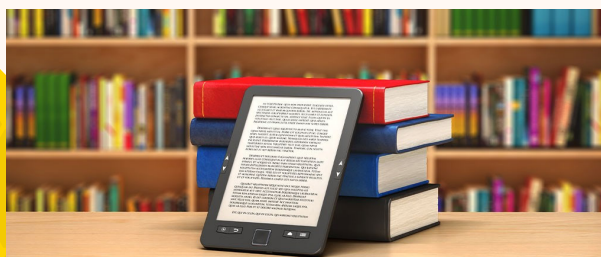


About the Seminar
